

2010 HONOR PATROL AWARD

The heart of scouting is the patrol. Camp is a great time to strengthen your patrol's unity and skills. This award may be earned by any patrol attending a summer session at Camp Tahquitz and completing the following requirements.

PART 1. COMPLETE ALL EIGHT

- _____ Commissioner. 1. Camp as a patrol.
- _____ Troop Guide 2. All Patrol members wear the Scout uniform on arrival and at campfires.
- _____ Nature Director 3. All patrol members perform a pre-approved Good Turn Service Project or participate in a conservation project of at least one-hour.
- _____ Scoutmaster 4. Have each patrol member below the rank of Tenderfoot complete all the requirements for Tenderfoot except for Requirement 10B.
- _____ Scoutmaster 5. Have each patrol member above the rank of Tenderfoot complete requirements for Second or First Class.
- _____ Commissioner 6. Show Scout Spirit at all times in camp.
- _____ Commissioner 7. Have a Patrol Flag
- _____ Commissioner 8. Create a written list of possible patrol activities or goals for the year.

PART II COMPLETE SIX OF THE FOLLOWING

- _____ Commissioner 9. For patrol feeding troops, cook as a patrol. For central feed, sign up as a service patrol for a day.
- _____ Commissioner 10. Participate in the camp wide games.
- _____ Aquatics 11. Participate in the Water Carnival
- _____ Nature Director 12. Pick up one 10-12 gal bag of trash on camp trails and from outside the campsite. Bring to the Nature Center, and then the camp's trash dumpster
- _____ Craft Lodge 13. Participate in the Patrol Flag competition. You may have either a pre-made flag, or a flag made at camp.
- _____ Commissioner 14. Participate in a commissioner area troop campfire.
- _____ Trail Guide 15. Take a day hike of five miles as a patrol
- _____ Trail Guide 16. Participate in a Wrangler or Bike overnigher.
- _____ Trail Guide 17. Go on an overnight camping trip in the San Gorgonio Wilderness.
